Monday 1st, Tuesday 2nd and Wednesday 3rd April – Days Three, Four and Five: Rehearsals at Argus Community Centre, Goslawdales, Selkirk, TD7 4EP. Times for the rehearsal days – **10am to 5pm**

Thursday 4th April - Day Six: Rehearsal day at Victoria Hall, Scott's Place, Selkirk, TD7 4LN. Times on rehearsal days - **10am to 5pm**

Friday 5th April – Day Seven: Show day at Victoria Hall, Scott's Place, Selkirk, TD7 4LN, with rehearsals starting at 12 Noon, performance 7pm and expected finish time 8.30pm. Start time - **12 Noon.**

Saturday 6th April - Day Eight: Show day. The cast need to arrive at Victoria Hall at 10am to be ready for the first show at Victoria Hall at 11am. The second show is at 3pm and will be followed by an after party finishing around 5.30pm. Start Time – **10am.**
